



#### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

- 1. Students must follow the code of conduct within the school premises.
- 2. Students must wear neat and tidy uniform. Girls must plate their hair properly.
- 3. Girls are not allowed to wear flowers, fancy items and sleeveless dresses.
- 4. Students must clip their nails and have a proper hair cut (fashion hair cut is not allowed).
- 5. Students must respect their parents, teachers and all elders and maintain discipline.
- 6. Students must maintain 85% of attendance in an academic year.
- 7. Unnecessary leaves are not entertained.
