## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. Students must follow the code of conduct within the school premises.
2. Students must wear neat and tidy uniform. Girls must plate their hair properly.
3. Girls are not allowed to wear flowers, fancy items and sleeveless dresses.
4. Students must clip their nails and have a proper hair cut (fashion hair cut is not allowed).
5. Students must respect their parents, teachers and all elders and maintain discipline.
6. Students must maintain 85% of attendance in an academic year.
7. Unnecessary leaves are not entertained.
8. Students must avail leaves by producing a leave letter as signed by the Parents/Guardian in advance.
9. In case of leaves exceed four days parents must submit a medical certificate.
10. Parents are not allowed to visit the student and the teacher during school hours .
11. Parents can meet the teachers only after 3.30 p.m or during Saturdays.
12. Parents can meet the Principal during the school hours.
13. Parents must attend the parents meeting without fail.
14. Students must report to the class teacher before 9.20 a.m failing would be marked as Absent for the fore noon session.
15. Parents are not allowed to take the children during the school hours unless there is an emergency.
16. Students are not allowed to take non-veg and breakfast as lunch except on Saturdays.

17. Students must follow the campus language code (English) inside the school campus.
18. Using vernacular language, wearing improper uniform and haircut will be penalized.
19. Parents must sign the diary after checking the daily home works unless the students are not permitted in the class.
20. Students must bring hot water, napkin, hand kerchief, spoon and all other required materials without fail daily.
21. In case of missing their possessions the parents are asked to report to the school the next day itself.
22. Students are not strictly allowed to wear gold, silver ornaments or carry valuable possessions to the school.
23. Students from Grade VI are only allowed to wear wrist watch.
24. Students must maintain the School Diary, ID card and Report card without any damage, unless the same to be replaced by a new one.
25. Vandalizing school properties is a punishable offence and the same must be replaced or penalized.
26. In case of change in transport the parents must intimate the same by availing a Transportation form.
27. Students are not allowed to wear Colour dress, distribute chocolates or gifts during birthdays either can present a sapling or a book to the school set st

29. School is only answerable to the parent or guardian (absence of parent)
